FIX PM is a liquid-grade polyelectrolyte with a very high cationic charge density, specially developed for wet-end papermaking applications. It is designed to fix anionic trash, fines, fillers, and dispersed pigments, significantly improving system cleanliness, drainage, and formation. Additionally, FIX PM acts as an antifluff and anti-linting agent, reducing the generation of fiber debris and improving the runnability and print quality of the final paper sheet.

#### **APPLICATIONS**

The recommended dosage is typically between 0.02% and 0.1% based on dry fiber weight

## **SPECIFIC PROPERTIES**

Efficiently fixes dyes, mineral fillers, rosin size, paraffin wax emulsions, starch, CMC, and polymer dispersions to the paper fiber.

Reduces fiber linting and dusting, while improving retention of ash and fines in the paper sheet. Acts as a strong coagulant to neutralize anionic trash and colloids; effective across pH 4.0–8.5.

#### **PACKAGING**

125, 140, 150 Kgs plastic drums or, 1000 Tank.

#### **STORAGE**

This product has a shelf life of 6 months in the original closed container at temprature between 5°C, 30°C. Once container has been opened, the contents should be used directly, container should be closed tightly after each use.
